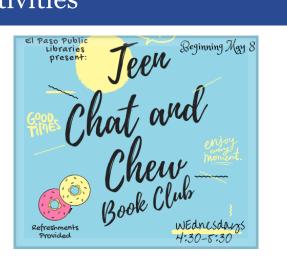
REALIZE Board Training
